

Pacific Hills Christian School has some construction work underway. This work is adjacent to the oval and as such the school has requested that we adhere to the following instructions regarding access to and movement around the oval.

- The Bus Bay area, which is normally used for parking, will not be available for the whole season. All parking is to be done in the main car park of the school.
- Ambulance access to the ground (if required) will be via the existing roadway, through the building site compound and onto the oval. The gates to the compound must be unlocked, but not opened, at the time of dressing the oval each Saturday.
- Retrieval of soccer balls kicked into the construction zone during the game is prohibited. Any balls kicked into the area will be given to the club each Monday for return to the various teams.
- No one is permitted to enter the building site compound next to the oval, or the construction zone.
- PHDSC will investigate and supply matting along the compound fence at the western end of the ground for player safety.
- A map has been attached to show the construction zone and the approved parking area within the school grounds.

In addition to these measures, may I restate, the school is an alcohol and smoke free zone. Neither player nor spectator is permitted to drink alcohol or smoke on the school grounds. Please ensure your teams and GHFA are aware of this restriction.
